State and federal agencies warn of potential increase in flash flooding

Flood and fire officials from DWR, CAL FIRE, and the National Weather Service (NWS) warn that weather and land conditions across California increase the potential for flash flooding during the rainy season, which is now under way. Five years of drought conditions have exacerbated wildfires across the state. Rain is beginning to fall on fire burn scars, making these areas prone to sudden erosion along roads and through neighborhoods. State officials and the NWS urge the public to begin preparations for potential flood events. More information is in this [news release](#).
