Delta conveyance is part of ACWA-commissioned study that examines water supply system

The Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) has posted a [technical study](#) it commissioned to examine how California's water supply system could operate more flexibly and effectively with the addition and integrated operation of new storage capacity. The study should generate discussion of a new approach to water storage integration as the California Water Commission conducts its public process to allocate \$2.7 billion from Proposition 1 to help fund water storage projects.
