The independent scientific panel, convened by the Delta Stewardship Council's [Delta Science Program](#), evaluated the analytical tools developed for comparing the range of proposed alternatives for the Yolo Bypass Fish Passage and Habitat Restoration Program Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report and Biological Assessment.
