Jim Fiedler is the Chief Operating Officer for the Santa Clara Valley Water District's Water Utility Enterprise. He has served in this capacity since 2007. He is responsible for leading Santa Clara's water policy development and program implementation of its water importation, surface reservoir operations, groundwater management, raw and treated water delivery, wholesale treated water, water recycling and water conservation programs.

A member of the water district staff since 1982 he has over 30 years of leadership and engineering experience in the area of water supply, flood control and watershed stewardship. His management and technical experience includes regional water resources, flood and environmental planning, design, construction, operations and maintenance of water supply and flood protection infrastructure.
