San Francisco District Commander Lieutenant Colonel Torrey A. DiCiro assumed command of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers San Francisco District July 13, 2010 after serving the past two years as Assistant Corps Engineer for the North Atlantic Treaty Organization Rapid Deployment Corps in Milan, Italy, during which he deployed as the Chief of Infrastructure and Resources for NATO's International Security Assistance Force Headquarters in Kabul, Afghanistan.

Lt. Col. DiCiro was commissioned a second lieutenant after earning a Bachelor of Science degree in civil engineering from the United States Military Academy, West Point, NY, in 1993. His previous assignments include Platoon Leader & Battalion S4, 317th Engineer Bn., Fort Benning, GA; Assistant S3 & Company Commander, 30th Engineer Bn., Fort Bragg, N.C.; Project Engineer, Force Protected Barracks and Warehouses, Naval Support Activity – Bahrain, Transatlantic Programs Center (TAC), Winchester, Va. in 2002; Project Engineer, Utilities, Runways, Aviation Support, Camp Arifjan, Camp Udari, Camp Victory, Kuwait/Iraq Programs Office, TAC, Winchester, Va. in 2002-2003; Resident Engineer, U.S. Naval Forces Central Command Headquarters, Force Protected Barracks, and Medical/Dental Clinic, Transatlantic Command (renamed the Middle East District), Winchester, Va. from 2003-2005; Brigade Engineer, 4/82nd, Fort Bragg, N.C. in 2006-2008 (Task Force Fury, Forward Observation Base Salerno, Afghanistan from Jan 07 to Apr 08); NATO Infrastructure Chief, in 2009 with CJ-ENG, HQ-ISAF in Kabul, Afghanistan; and served as Assistant Corps Engineer, NATO Rapid Deployable Corps – Milan, Italy.

He earned a Master of Science degree in engineering management from the University of Missouri-Rolla in 1997, and Master of Science degrees in civil engineering and business administration from the Georgia Institute of Technology in 2001.
