On March 16, 1989 the Commission amended the San Francisco Bay Plan by revising the section entitled "Ports" as indicated below. These pages may be inserted in the Bay Plan prior to the next reprinting.

## Policies

The following <u>underlined</u> language has been added to Policy 1 of the Bay Plan Policies on Ports.

- Port planning and development should be governed by the policies of the Seaport Plan and other applicable policies of the Bay Plan. The Seaport Plan provides for:
  - a. Expansion and/or redevelopment of port facilities at Alameda, Benicia, Oakland, Redwood City, Richmond, and San Francisco and development of new port facilities at Vallejo and Selby.

The San Francisco Bay Plan Maps would be changed as indicated on the following maps (Figures 1 through 3) entitled "Changes to the Bay Plan Maps concerning Ports."





FIGURE 1

Concerning Ports


