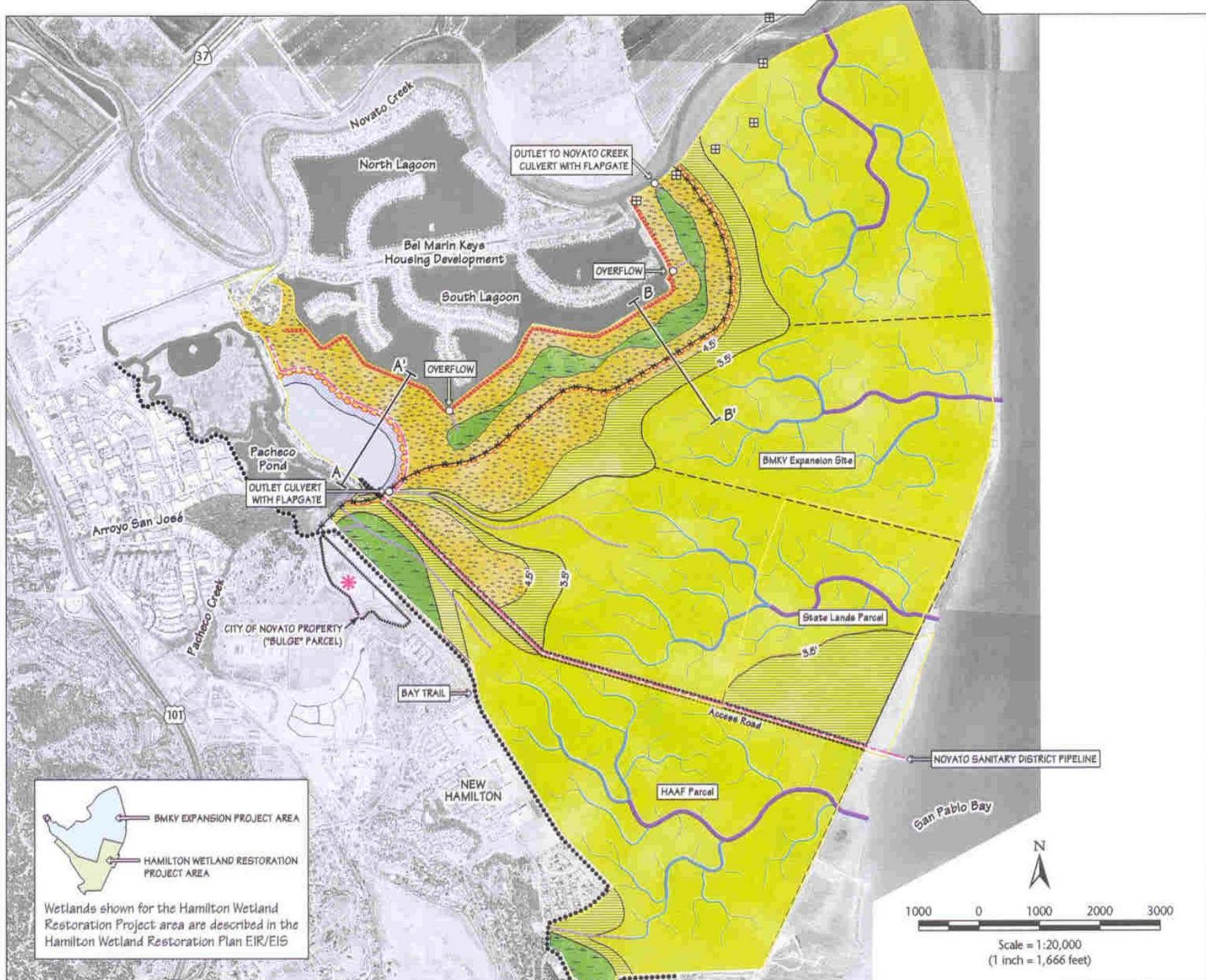


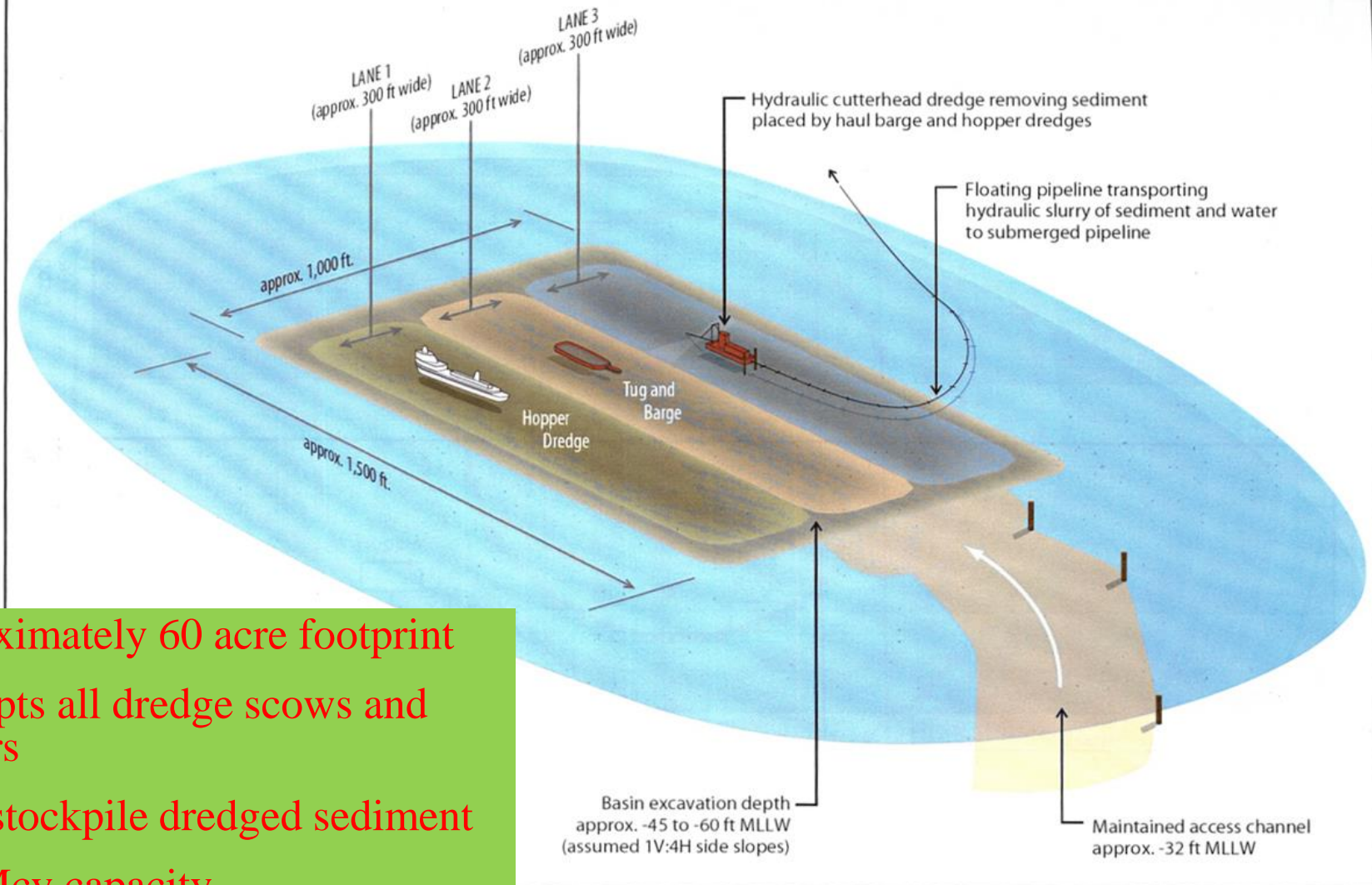

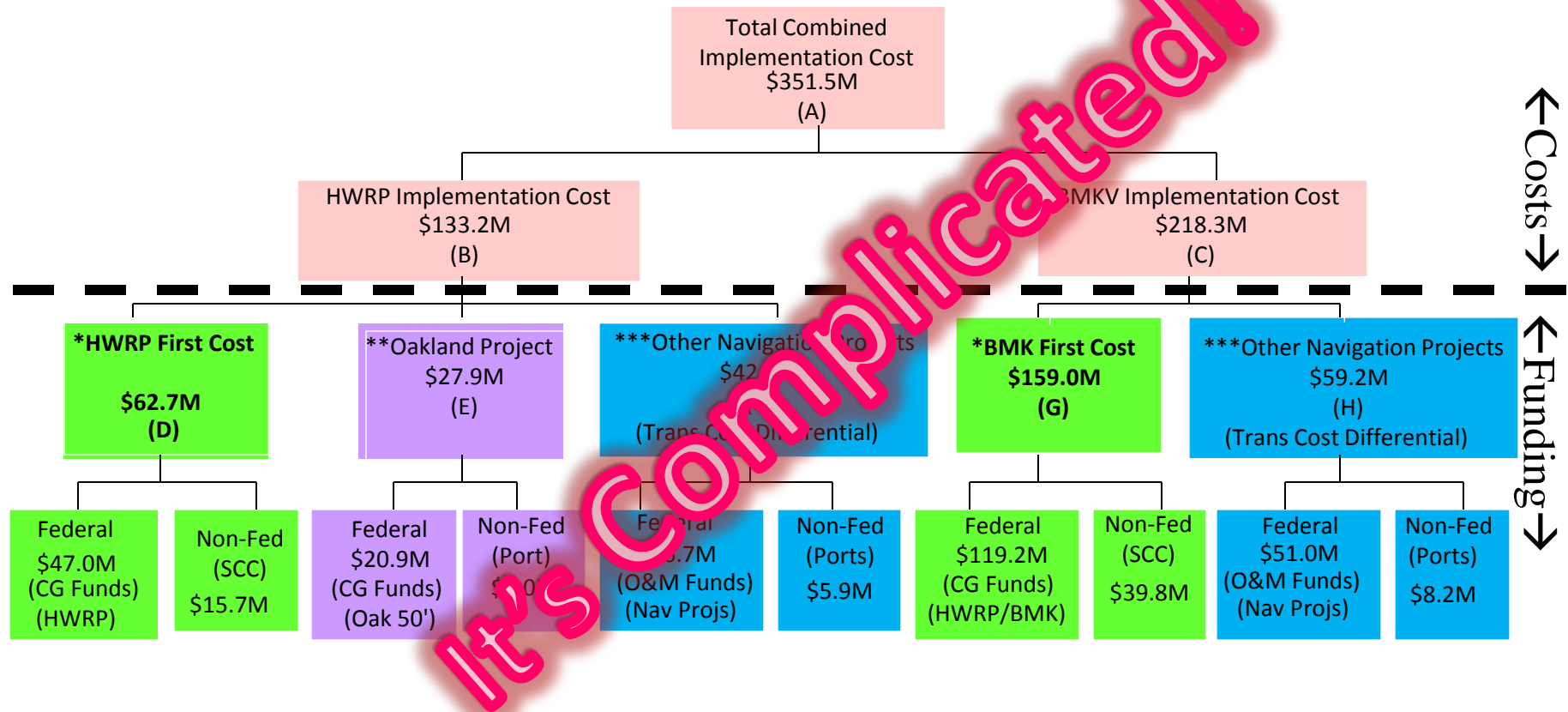
Approximately 60 acre footprint
