Note: Only water agencies that provide water directly to individual households have state reduction requirements. A number of important Bay Area water agencies—including the Sonoma County Water Agency, Santa Clara Valley Water District, Solano County Water Agency, Zone 7 Water Agency, and Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency (BAWSCA)—do not have state targets but are working with their “retail” agency customers and member agencies to address the drought.
