Delta Stewardship Council 2-day meeting is February 23-24

The Delta Stewardship Council (Council) will meet February 23–24 in Sacramento. Agenda items include recent accomplishments and upcoming activities of the Delta Independent Science Board, 2017 Council priorities, California WaterFix update, and draft amendments to the Delta Plan. Delta Protection Commission posts 2016 Annual Report

The Delta Protection Commission has posted its 2016 Annual Report. Topics in the report are land use and resource management, land and water, levees and emergency response, regional economy, Delta heritage, recreation and tourism, and outreach and education.

CVRWQCB posts February 2017 Executive Officer's Report and Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Delta Program Fact Sheet

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (CVRWQCB) has posted the February 2017 *Executive Officer's Report*. The report is part of the CVRWQCB February 2017 meeting agenda and is sent to the Board members before each CVRWQCB meeting, which occurs at least six times per calendar year. The report describes CVRWQCB involvement in many Delta issues.

Also, the CVRWQCB has posted the *Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Delta Program Fact Sheet*. The fact sheet summarizes the fiscal year 2016-2017 priority activities of the Delta Water Quality Program. The program's goals are to coordinate with the State Water Resources Control Board and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board about planning and permits that affect Delta water quality and to implement the *2014 Delta Strategic Work Plan*.

Save the date — workshop on contaminants of emerging concern is May 1-2

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) and the Delta Science Program will conduct a two-day workshop on contaminants of emerging concern (CECs) May 1–2 in Sacramento. CECs encompass a vast number of chemicals that are generally unregulated in the United States including pharmaceuticals, flame retardants, pesticides, personal care products, commercial and industrial products, fragrances, hormones, antibiotics, and nanoparticles. The agenda for the workshop is being developed. The May 1 program has a statewide focus and the May 2 program has a Bay-Delta focus. More details are forthcoming.
