Delta Stewardship Council posts online video on carbon farming in the Delta

The Delta Stewardship Council has posted an [online video on carbon farming in the Delta](#). Carbon farming is a way for farmers to earn additional revenue for activities that help combat climate change and better manage land, water, plants, and animals. Campbell Ingram, Executive Officer of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy, and Dr. Steve Deverel, a Principal Hydrologist with Hydro Focus, explain how they have developed a carbon methodology. This is a set of rules for Delta landowners to quantify greenhouse gas emissions in the region and provide them with a monetary incentive to convert land they currently use for traditional crops, such as corn or alfalfa, to wetlands or rice cultivation, which absorb carbon from the air.

The University of California, Davis, [Center for Watershed Sciences](#) has posted the [Delta Consumptive Water Use Comparative Study](#). The study gathered, analyzed, and disseminated data about actual direct evaporation and plant transpiration in the Delta (sometimes referred to as evapotranspiration or ET) and organized and used the ET data to facilitate comparative tests of up to seven selected methods for measuring consumptive use.
