Delta RMP TAC will meet September 21

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board's Delta Regional Monitoring Program (Delta RMP) Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) will meet September 21 in Sacramento. Key topics include reviewing *Final Draft Report — Year 1 Pesticides and Toxicity Data Report*, reviewing draft proposal evaluation criteria, planning the *Current Use Pesticides Year 1-2 Interpretive Report*, recruiting independent science advisors, and reviewing *Nutrients Synthesis Reports (Tasks 1 and 2)*. 2017–2018 Proposition 1 full proposals are due November 30

The 2017–2018 solicitation period for Concept Proposals to the Delta Conservancy's (Conservancy's) Ecosystem Restoration and Water Quality Grant Program closed August 31. Conservancy staff are reviewing concept proposals and will provide feedback to applicants by September 31.
