SWRCB hearing officers for California WaterFix issue two new ruling letters

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) hearing officers for California WaterFix issued a [new ruling letter November 8](#), which addresses questions raised by parties during the pre-hearing conference held October 19. This includes changes in the project, Delta flow criteria, reports authored by the State Water Resources Control Board, scope of Part 2 of the hearing, evidentiary objections, exhibit number for Final EIR/EIS, and an updated Part 2 hearing guidance document. Another [new ruling letter was issued November 13](#), which addresses the supplemental notice of intent to appear (NOI) filed by the San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors Water Authority and North Delta C.A.R.E.S., and the failure of several Part 2 parties to submit a supplemental NOI.

This project is a partnership of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy, the Delta Protection Commission, and the Delta Marketing Task Force. San Francisco Estuary Partnership posts 2016 San Francisco Estuary Blueprint

The [San Francisco Estuary Partnership](#) has posted the [2016 San Francisco Estuary Blueprint Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan](#). The San Francisco Estuary, which includes the San Francisco Bay, Suisun Marsh, and the upstream Delta, was included in the [National Estuary Program](#) in 1988. The San Francisco Estuary Partnership is the lead agency responsible to implement the program. Each designated estuary must develop a comprehensive conservation and management plan for protecting the estuary and its resources and identify actions to improve water quality, sediment quality, living resources, land use, and water resources.
