06/14 – 06/20

Thursday

- Moderate – high heat risk and critical fire weather conditions Central Valley and most of SoCal

Friday

- A slight chance of thunderstorms causing strong winds, blowing dust and fire starts in the SE
- Critical fire weather conditions due to dry, warm and windy weather most of Central and SoCal

Saturday-Wednesday


- Dry and breezy conditions continue for most areas of the State.

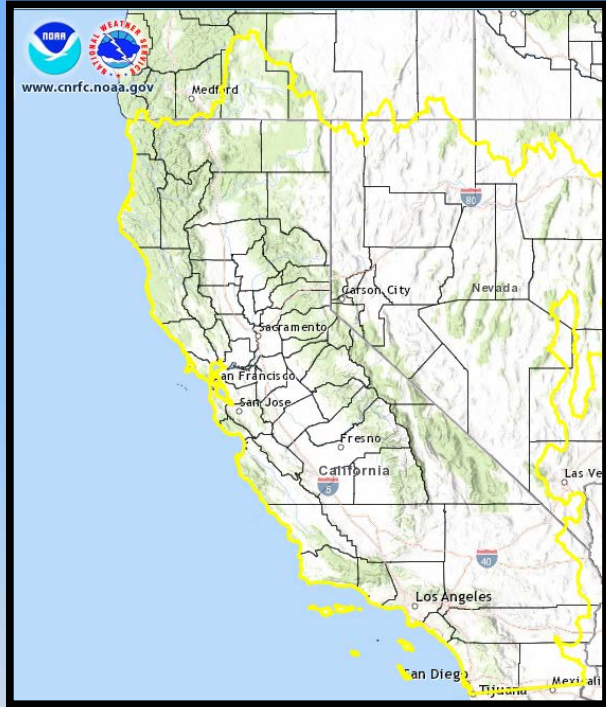

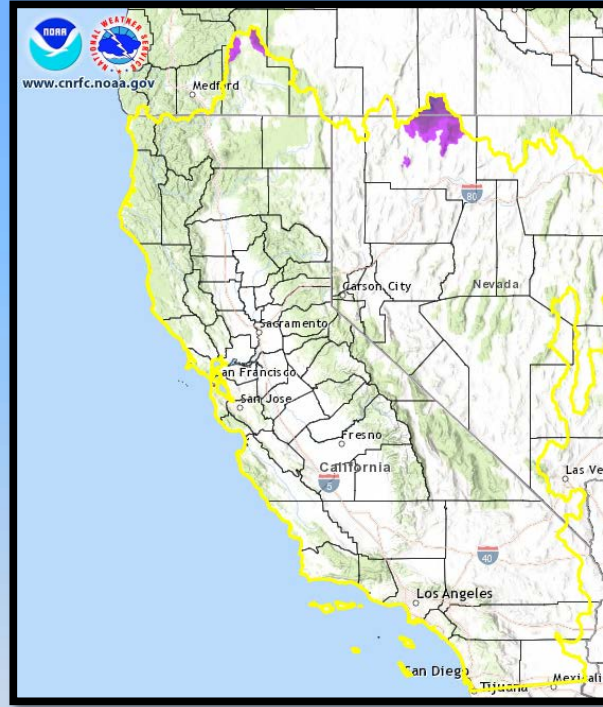

Days 1-3 Precipitation Forecast

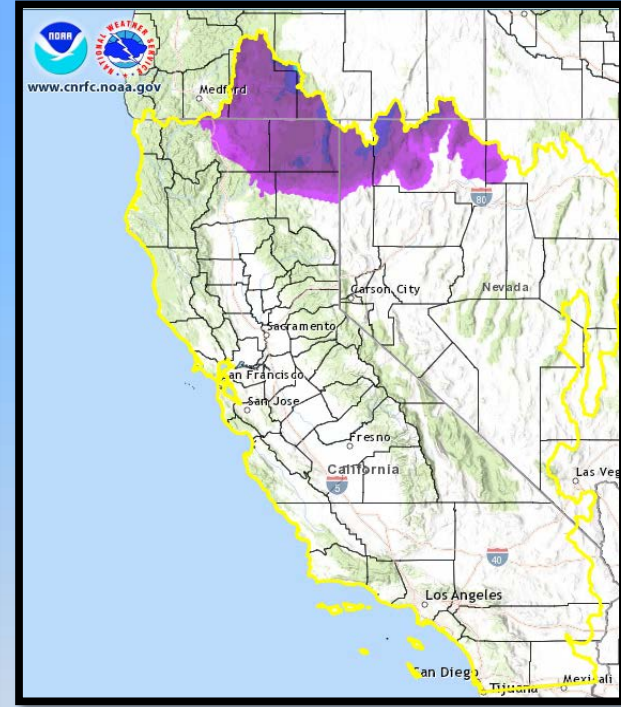
Precipitation (inches)

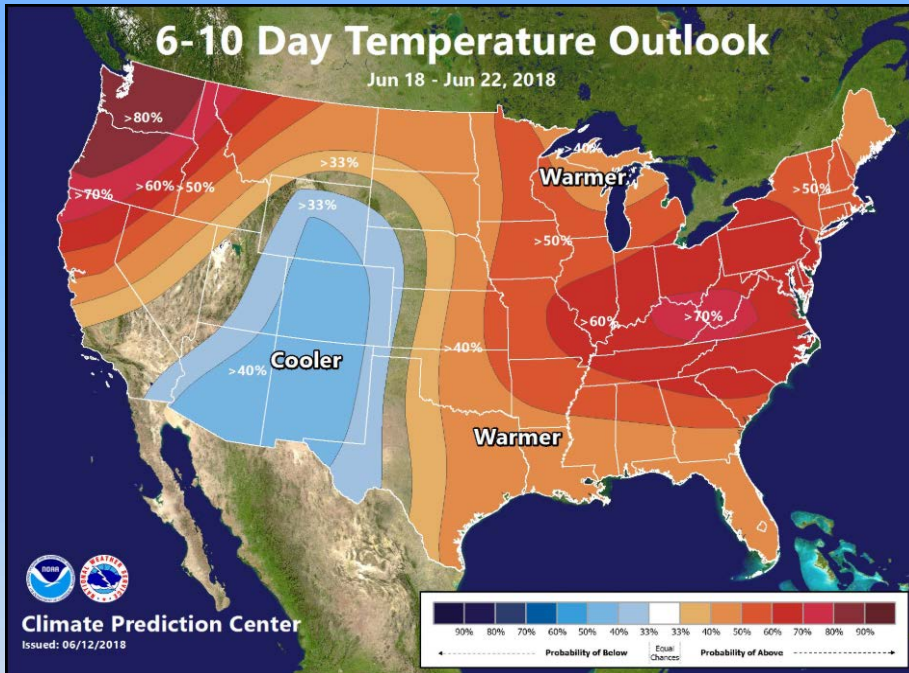

Very little (or no) rain through Saturday

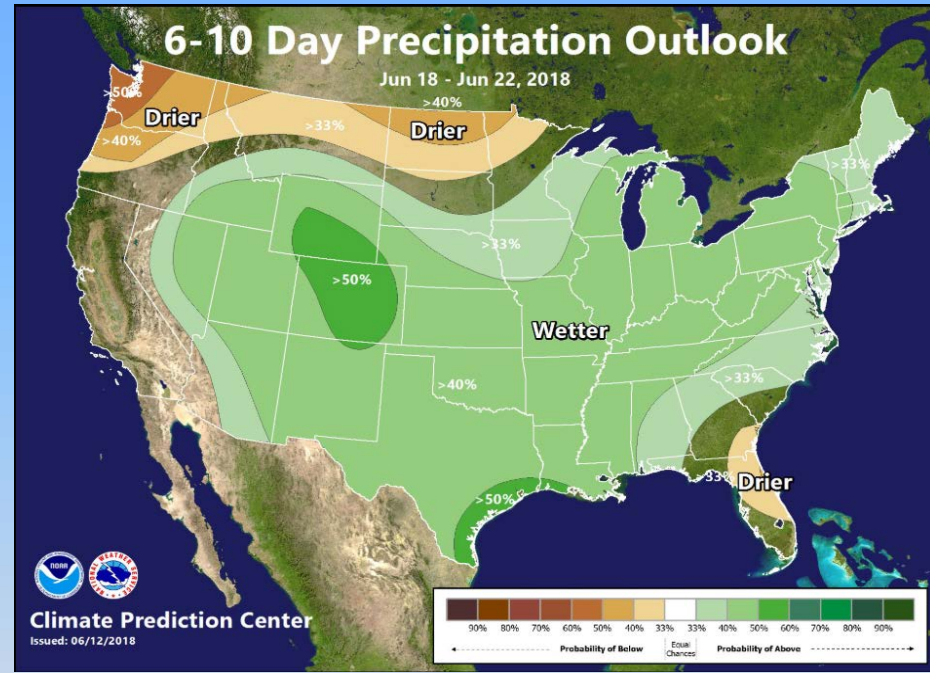


6-10 Day Outlook

Precipitation



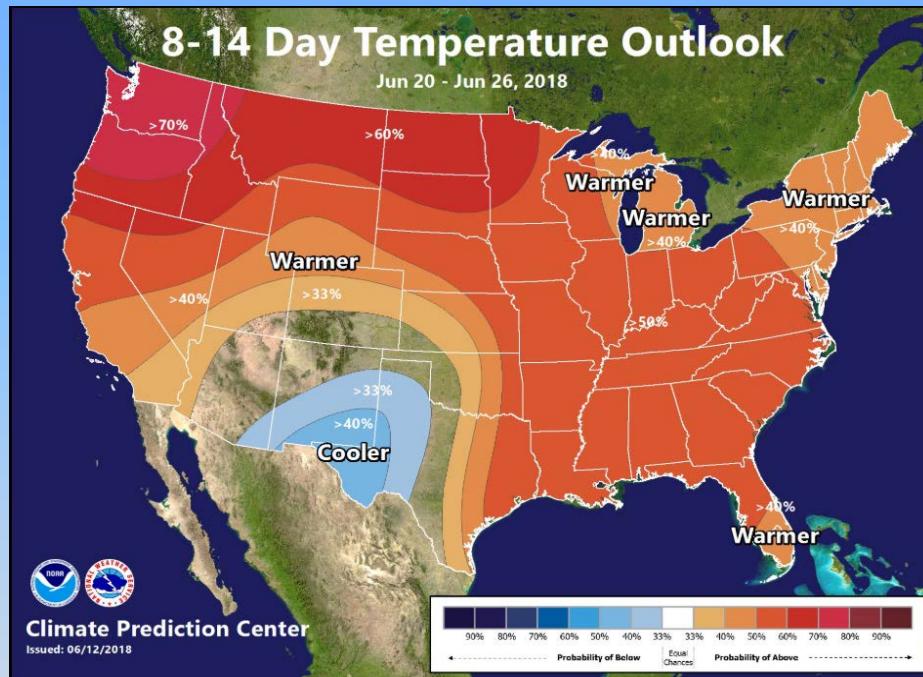
Warmer than normal temperatures are likely across nrn CA, with normal elsewhere.

Odds are for normal precipitation during the period.

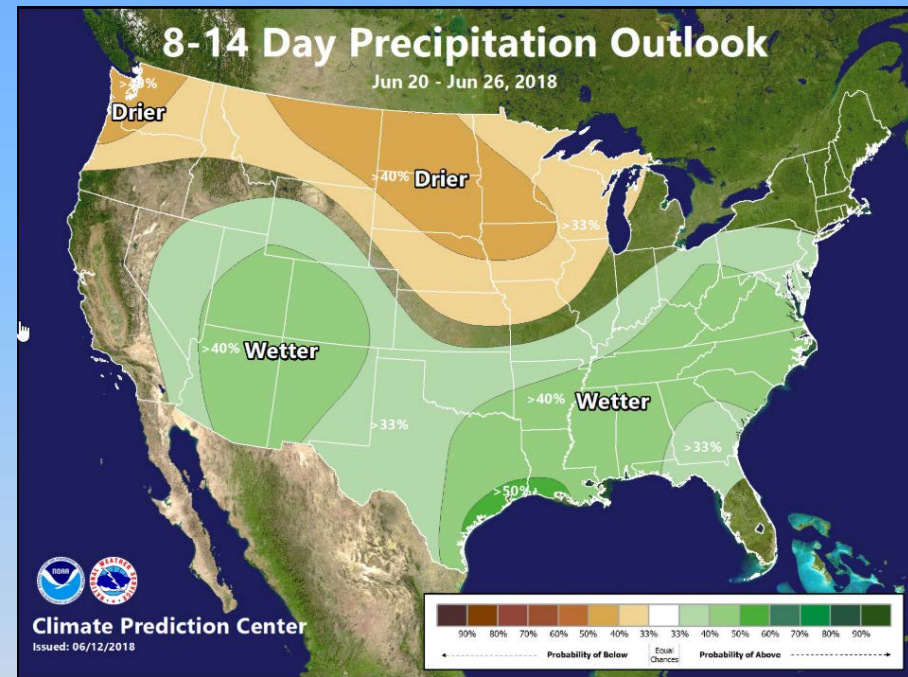


8-14 Day Outlook
