Day 1: Very high heat risk continues, especially in the southern portions of California and the northern interior.

# **Key Points**

07/26 - 08/01

### **Thursday-Friday**

- Very high heat risk, especially in southern California and Interior Valleys
- Isolated thunderstorms in the Sierra-Nevada mountain range both Thursday and Friday
- Strong sundowner winds will create critical fire weather conditions in the Santa Barbara County mountains and South Coast through Thursday

## Saturday-Wednesday

- Some cooling is expected, but temperatures will remain warm, especially in the interior
- Additional moisture could bring isolated thunderstorms with a threat of flash flooding to far southern CA Sunday through Wednesday
- Continued warm and dry conditions could lead to pockets of elevated fire weather concerns







# Heat Risk for Saturday, July 28, 2018 Cooling, but Still Warm; Similar Sunday and Into Next Week




# **Days 1-3 Precipitation Forecast**




# 6-10 Day Outlook

#### **Precipitation**






