- **Dry conditions. No rain expected.**
- **Elevated fire weather conditions may persist into part of Friday, then return Monday through Wednesday.**

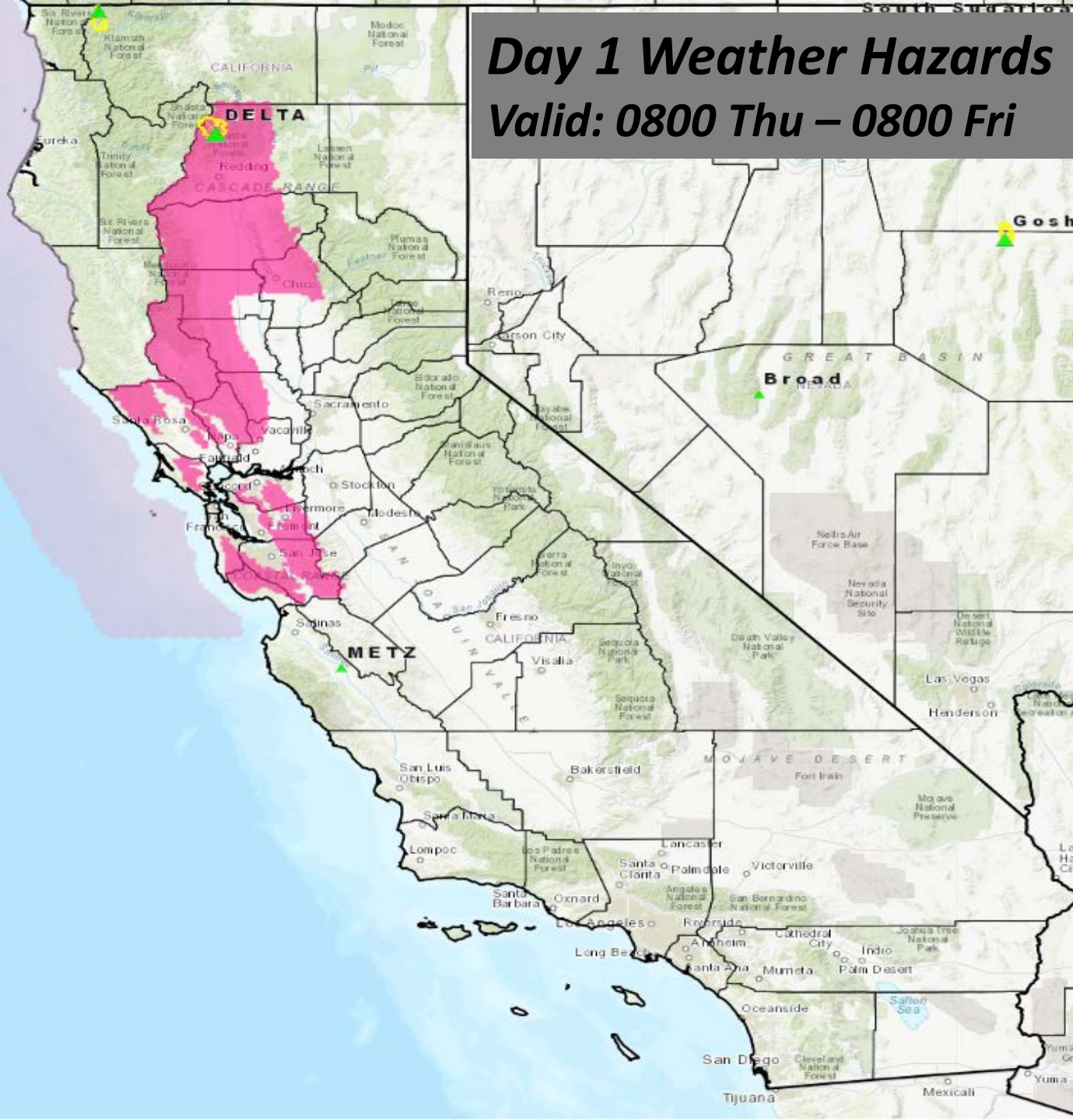

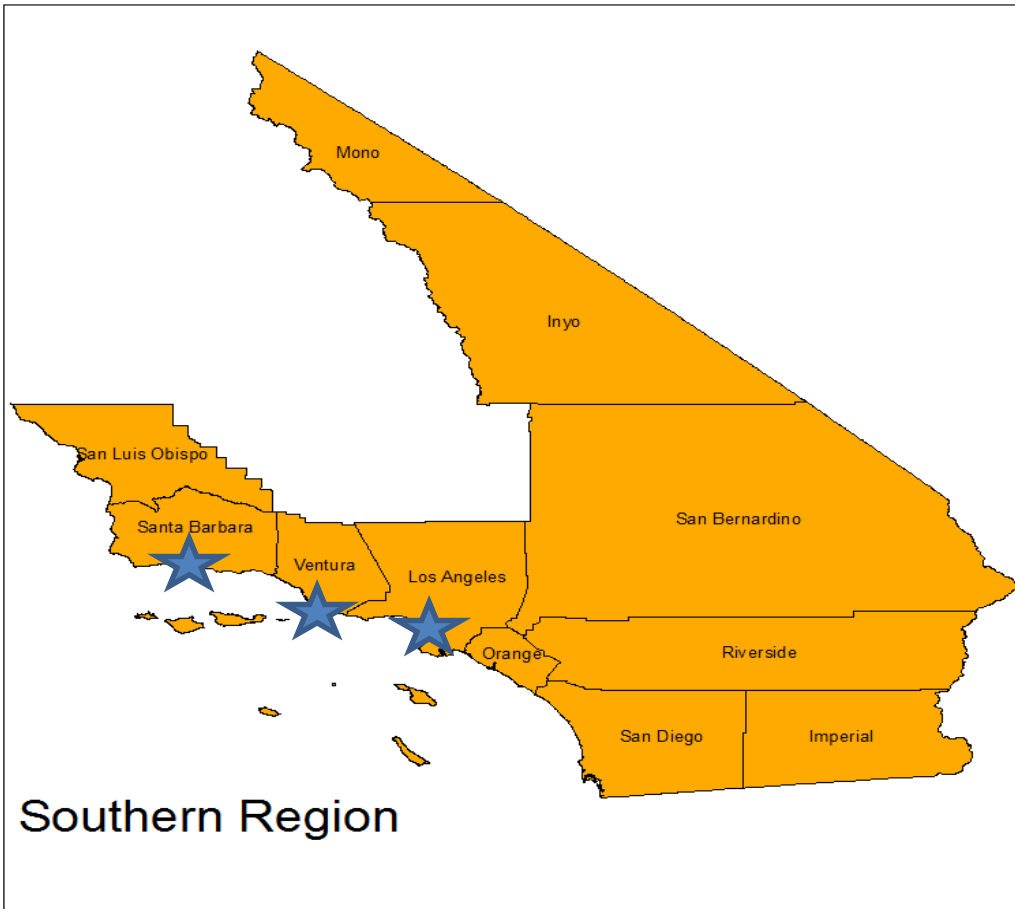
