## **Energy & Water Committee**

On April 24th, our Energy & Water Committee held its first meeting of the year. In light of the recent weather events, which provided much-needed relief to drought conditions, the committee meeting focused on the State's hydrology and the future of reservoir operations with Forecast Informed Reservoir Operations (FIRO). To assist in this dialogue, the committee welcomed *Michael Anderson*, State Climatologist with California's Department of Water Resources (DWR), and *Jack Xu*, Senior Engineer with Valley Water.

This week, the Government Affairs Committee met to discuss recent legislative updates on bills of interest to BPC and our members as the legislature reaches a key deadline today. We also had members join us to present on two legislative efforts that BPC is involved in, SB 272 (Laird) and SBX1-2 (Skinner).

Bay Planning Coalition has dropped our opposition to SB 272, and is appreciative of Senator Laird and his staff for working with us, Bay Area Council, California Business Industry Association (CBIA) and the Bay Area Business Industry Association (BIA Bay Area) on amending the initial bill.

## **USACE Open House**

Join the **US Army Corps of Engineers San Francisco District** at their 2023 Dredging Open House on Tuesday, May 23 from 9 – 12.

The U.S. spends \$60 million annually to dredge the waterways of the San Francisco Bay and parts of Northern California to support commercial navigation and connect local ports to global markets. Dredging is also a valuable climate adaptation tool: providing sediment to build up tidal wetlands and shoreline communities that are vulnerable to sea level rise.

## WETA Wins \$13.8 Million Grant to Electrify Ferry Facilities in San Francisco and East Bay

The San Francisco Bay Area Water Emergency Transportation Authority (WETA), the agency that provides San



Francisco Bay Ferry service, announced that it has won a \$13.8 million grant from the California State Transportation Agency (CalSTA) to electrify ferry terminals and facilities in San Francisco and the East Bay.

The grant will fund electric infrastructure and increased charging capacity to the Downtown San Francisco Ferry Terminal, the Main Street Alameda Ferry Terminal and WETA's Central Bay Operations and Maintenance Facility in Alameda. This project will allow WETA to operate zero-emission, electric ferries on San Francisco Bay Ferry's routes connecting Oakland and Alameda to San Francisco.
