Dredging & Beneficial Reuse Committee

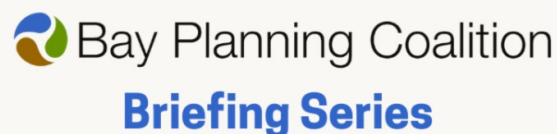

Additionally, the Committee welcomed two speakers: 1) BCDC staff provided a presentation on their multi-year EPA and OPC funded project to facilitate beneficial reuse for wetland restoration as they begin engaging stakeholders to develop a regional sediment roadmap, and 2) Xavier Fernandez, Planning Division Manager with the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board (SFRWQCB) and LTMS Program Manager, answered Committee members' questions.
