Advocacy Efforts

Supporting a Healthier San Francisco Bay



BPC is actively urging congressional leaders to include \$54 million in the FY 2026 Interior Appropriations bill for the EPA's San Francisco Bay Program. The Bay is the largest estuary on the West Coast, home to over 100 threatened species, and a vital water source for 25 million Californians.

While past funding has helped, decades of underinvestment demand renewed commitment. This increased support will accelerate habitat restoration, improve water quality, and protect shoreline communities from flooding, critical actions for the Bay's future and the people and wildlife who depend on it.

BPC Opposes SB 601



This month, BPC submitted a letter of opposition for SB 601 (Allen), joining a growing list of organizations concerned with the bill's duplicative regulations for "nexus water." The bill adds unnecessary complexity, risks diverting resources from real environmental needs, and preempts a thoughtful state review already in progress.
