Mr. Goldbeck is the acting Executive Director at the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC). Prior to that he that served as BCDC's Chief Deputy Director. Mr. Goldbeck has twenty-seven years experience at BCDC and has been overseeing the Commission's climate change and sea level rise response program for the last three years, including helping to prepare the coastal sector of the California State Adaptation Strategy. He served as the staff legislative coordinator for over a decade and was the Commission's lead staff member on dredging and sediment management issues for over 15 years. He co-authored the section of the Estuary Project's Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan on dredging and waterway modification and oversaw the 2007 update. He was a principal architect of the interagency LTMS program and Management Plan, including the creation of the award-winning Dredged Material Management Office (DMMO), and served as the Commission's project manager for the Hamilton Wetlands Restoration Project. Mr. Goldbeck holds a Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Planning and Public Policy from the University of California at Santa Cruz.
